OT Prophecy	Description	NT Fulfillment
Gen. 3:15	Seed of a woman	Gal. 4:4
<p>Genesis 3:15 — And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.</p> <p>Galatians 4:4 — But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,</p>		
Gen. 18:18	Promised seed of Abraham	Mat. 1:1
<p>Genesis 18:18 — Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?</p> <p>Matthew 1:1 — The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.</p>		
Gen. 17:19	Promised seed of Isaac	Mat. 1:2
<p>Genesis 17:19 — And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.</p> <p>Matthew 1:2 — Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;</p>		
Num. 24:17	Promised seed of Jacob	Luke 3:34
<p>Numbers 24:17 — I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth.</p> <p>Luke 3:34 — Which was the son of Jacob, which was the son of Isaac, which was the son of Abraham, which was the son of Thara, which was the son of Nachor,</p>		
Gen. 49:10	From the tribe of Judah	Luke 3:33
<p>Genesis 49:10 — The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.</p> <p>Luke 3:33 — Which was the son of Aminadab, which was the son of Aram, which was the son of Esrom, which was the son of Phares, which was the son of Juda,</p>		
Isa. 9:7	Heir to throne of David	Mat. 1:1
<p>Isaiah 9:7 — Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.</p> <p>Matthew 1:1 — The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.</p>

OT Prophecy	Description	NT Fulfillment
Micah 5:2	Place of birth	Mat. 2:1
<p>Micah 5:2 — But thou, Beth-lehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.</p> <p>Matthew 2:1 — Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem,</p>		
Dan 9:25	Time of birth	Luke 1:67-71
<p>Daniel 9:25 — Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.</p> <p>Luke 1:67-71 — And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied, saying, Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began: That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us;</p>		
Isa. 7:14	Born of a virgin	Mat. 1:18
<p>Isaiah 7:14 — Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.</p> <p>Matthew 1:18 — Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.</p>		
Jer. 31:15	Massacre of infants	Mat. 2:16
<p>Jeremiah 31:15 — Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, and bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they were not.</p> <p>Matthew 2:16 — Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wrath, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently inquired of the wise men.</p>		
Hos. 11:1	Flight into Egypt	Mat. 2:14
<p>Hosea 11:1 — When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.</p> <p>Matthew 2:14 — When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt:</p>

OT Prophecy	Description	NT Fulfillment
Isa. 9:1-2	Ministry in Galilee	Mat. 4:12-16
<p>Isaiah 9:1-2 — Nevertheless the dimness shall not be such as was in her vexation, when at the first he lightly afflicted the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, and afterward did more grievously afflict her by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, in Galilee of the nations. The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined.</p> <p>Matthew 4:12-16 — Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, he departed into Galilee; And leaving Nazareth, he came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is upon the sea coast, in the borders of Zabulon and Nephtholim: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephtholim, by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles; The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.</p>		
Deu. 18:16	Prophet	John 6:14
<p>Deuteronomy 18:16 — According to all that thou desiredst of the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not.</p> <p>John 6:14 — Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.</p>		
Psa. 110:4	Priest like Melchizedek	Heb. 6:20
<p>Psalms 110:4 — The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.</p> <p>Hebrews 6:20 — Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.</p>		
Isa. 53:3	Rejection by the Jews	John 1:11, Luke 23:18
<p>Isaiah 53:3 — He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.</p> <p>Luke 23:18 — And they cried out all at once, saying, Away with this man, and release unto us Barabbas:</p>		
Isa. 11:2	Some Characteristics	Luke 2:52
<p>Isaiah 11:2 — And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;</p> <p>Luke 2:52 — And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.</p>

OT Prophecy	Description	NT Fulfillment
Zec. 9:9	Triumphal entry	John 12:13-14
<p>Zechariah 9:9 — Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.</p> <p>John 12:13-14 — Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord. And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,</p>		
Psa. 41:9	Betrayed by friend	Mark 14:10
<p>Psalm 41:9 — Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up his heel against me.</p> <p>Mark 14:10 — And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went unto the chief priests, to betray him unto them.</p>		
Zec. 11:12	Sold for thirty pieces of silver	Mat. 26:15
<p>Zechariah 11:12 — And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver.</p> <p>Matthew 26:15 — And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.</p>		
Zec. 11:13	Money returned for potter's field	Mat. 27:6-7
<p>Zechariah 11:13 — And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.</p> <p>Matthew 27:6-7 — And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood. And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.</p>		
Psa. 27:12	False witnesses	Mat. 26:60-61
<p>Psalm 27:12 — Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.</p> <p>Matthew 26:60-61 — But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. At the last came two false witnesses, And said, This fellow said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days.</p>		
Isa. 53:7	Silent when accused	Mat. 26:62-63
<p>Isaiah 53:7 — He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.</p> <p>Matthew 26:62-63 — And the high priest arose, and said unto him, Answerest thou nothing? what is it which these witness against thee? But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.</p>

OT Prophecy	Description	NT Fulfillment
Isa. 50:6	Smitten and spat upon	Mark 14:65
<p>Isaiah 50:6 — I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.</p> <p>Mark 14:65 — And some began to spit on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him, Prophesy: and the servants did strike him with the palms of their hands.</p>		
Psa. 69:4	Hated without cause	John 15:23-25
<p>Psalms 69:4 — They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, being mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored that which I took not away.</p> <p>John 15:23-25 — He that hateth me hateth my Father also. If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father. But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.</p>		
Isa. 53:4-5	Suffered vicariously	Mat. 8:16-17
<p>Isaiah 53:4-5 — Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.</p> <p>Matthew 8:16-17 — When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.</p>		
Isa. 53:12	Crucified with sinners	Mat. 27:38
<p>Isaiah 53:12 — Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.</p> <p>Matthew 27:38 — Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left.</p>		
Psa. 22:16	Hands and Feet pierced	John 20:27
<p>Psalms 22:16 — For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet.</p> <p>John 20:27 — Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.</p>

OT Prophecy	Description	NT Fulfillment
Psa. 22:6-8	Mocked and insulted	Mat. 27:39-40
<p>Psalm 22:6-8 — But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.</p> <p>Matthew 27:39-40 — And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads, And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the cross.</p>		
Psa. 69:21	Given gall and vinegar	John 19:29
<p>Psalm 69:21 — They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.</p> <p>John 19:29 — Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to his mouth.</p>		
Zec. 12:10	His side pierced	John 19:34
<p>Zechariah 12:10 — And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.</p> <p>John 19:34 — But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.</p>		
Psa. 22:18	Cast lots for his garment	John 19:24
<p>Psalm 22:18 — They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.</p> <p>John 19:24 — They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did.</p>		
Psa. 34:20	Not a bone broken	John 19:33
<p>Psalm 34:20 — He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken.</p> <p>John 19:33 — But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs:</p>		
Isa. 53:9	Buried with the rich	Mat. 27:57-60
<p>Isaiah 53:9 — And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.</p> <p>Matthew 27:57-60 — When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple: He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed.</p>

OT Prophecy	Description	NT Fulfillment
Psa. 16:10	Resurrection	Mat. 28:9
<p>Psalm 16:10 — For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.</p> <p>Matthew 28:9 — And as they went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and worshipped him.</p>		
Psa. 68:18	Ascension	Luke 24:50-51
<p>Psalm 68:18 — Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell among them.</p> <p>Luke 24:50-51 — And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them. And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.</p>
